During the First World War Canada incarcerated 8,579 men in 24 internment camps that were established across the country from Nanaimo British Columbia to Halifax Nova Scotia. The abandoned mining town of Morrissey, located in the South-East British Columbia, was such a camp. During the time that the Morrissey Camp was in operation, from September 1915 to October 1918, approximately 513 men were interned there.

Below the reader will find a comprehensive Nominal Roll of the PoWs who were interned at Morrissey as well as the names of some of the Military personnel who were assigned as Guards. The Nominal Roll is divided into four Parts.

Part I is an alphabetical list of the PoWs either retrieved from official Government records or provided by direct descendants and confirmed with photographs. The corresponding PoW numbers are recorded where available. In addition, the list includes all of the different spellings of the names noted in the records.

Part II is a numerical list based on the PoW number assigned to each prisoner. In all probability the initial 165 PoW numbers represents PoWs who were transferred from the Fernie Camp to the Morrissey Camp when the Fernie Internment Camp closed in September 1915. However, PoWs were more than just numbers, they were husbands, fathers, sons, brothers etc. and helped build this country of ours. I have therefore added as much personal information that could be found for as many individuals as possible. This information includes, where available: the prisoner's country and city of origin; the amount of money they earned and, in many cases never collected by them; their date of release, deportation, escape or death; and the names of the various Internment camps that the prisoners were interned in. The reader will note that there are many PoW numbers for which there are no names associated to it. This is no doubt due to the fact that many of the records were destroyed by the Government in the early 1950s.

Note on the spelling of the cities of origin: It is possible that the name of some of the cities of origin may be misspelled or may have changed names since 1918. They are written here as they were recorded in the documents from the Library and Archives Canada.

Part III is an alphabetical list of the Military personnel and their corresponding Rank who were assigned to guarding the camp. Here again the list is no doubt incomplete. As based on the records, a number of the Guards volunteered for overseas duty and those that were fit for the front lines were replaced in the camps with both soldiers whom were regarded as unfit for overseas service and those returning home from overseas.

Part IV consists of an analysis of the data including, where available: the monthly total of PoWs and Guards; the number of known nationalities of the PoWs; the number of PoWs released; the number who escaped; the number of deaths; and the number of PoWs who were deported/repatriated.

Nationalities of PoWs

Based on an analysis of the information contained in Part II during the operation of the Morrissey Camp from September 1915 to October 1918, the following were Interned: there were 82 PoW numbers for which no name could be found; 196 Austro-Hungarians, the majority being Ukrainians; 155 Germans; one Russian and one Bulgarian. Additionally there were 74 for whom no Nationality could be found.

PoWs Released

Also, 109 PoWs were released from the Morrissey Camp and three others were released from Camps they were transferred to after the Morrissey Camp was closed in October 1918.

Escapes

From the existing records 22 PoWs escaped from Morrissey, 2 escaped from the Munson Camp and one from the Eaton Camp. The latter three had been transferred after the Morrissey Camp closed.

Deaths

Four PoWs died of natural causes while at the Morrissey and were buried at the Morrissey Cemetery. In September 1970 the remains of PoW, Hermann Rellmann, a German National, were exhumed by the German War Graves Commission and re-buried at the Woodland Cemetery, Kitchener, Ontario. One Morrissey PoW, John Leeseman, who was transferred to the Munson Camp when the Morrissey Camp closed died while at Munson. Being a German National, his remains were also exhumed and re-buried at the Woodland Cemetery.

Deportation/Repatriation

Based on my review of the existing records I was able to confirm that 162 PoWs who had been at the Morrissey were deported. Of these 162, 26 were Austro-Hungarians. I also found that three PoWs were scheduled for Deportation however I could not locate any records to confirm their Deportation.

It should also be noted that for 123 PoWs I could not find any record of their disposition. As so many records are missing or incomplete it is possible that some may have been released or deported.
