The Committee of the Privy Council have had before them a Report, dated 27th. May, 1915, from the Minister of Justice, submitting that Major General Otter has applied for a further advance to meet the expenses of internment of prisoners of war, and has furnished the statement herewith submitted accounting for the expenditure of the advances previously made.

The Minister accordingly recommends that authority be granted for an advance of \$100,000. to Major General Otter, to be charged against the War Appropriation.

The Committee concur in the foregoing and submit the same for approval.
