The Committee of the Privy Council have had before them a report, dated 12th May, 1915, from the Honourable Sir George E. Foster, for the Prime Minister, recommending upon the report of the War Purchasing Commission, dated 10th May, 1915, that under the authority of Paragraph 1 of the Order in Council of May 8th, 1915, (P.C.1033), constituting the said Commission, Thomas Hilliard, Esquire, of St. Catharines, Ont., be appointed Secretary of the War Purchasing Commission with salary at the rate of \$350.00 a month, and that he be allowed ^{to date from May 10th} the sum of \$200.00 for personal moving expenses from St. Catharines to Ottawa.

The Committee concur in the foregoing recommendation and submit the same for approval.
