Employment Agent Held. Kynos Kyonoff, a Bulgarian, of 404 King street east, was remanded till to-morrow on a charge of engaging in the business of an intelligence agent, and dealing with immigrants without having a license from the Immigration Department. It is alleged that Kyonoff got \$10 each from six men for getting them jobs at Marmora, Ontario. The charge is laid by James C. Mitchell, inspector of employment agents for Ontario, and by D. H. Reynolds, traveling immigration inspector, who are both pressing a hot campaign against illegal agencies in Toronto. They have sworn out no less than 16 informations against local agents, to be answered in to-

morrow afternoon's Police Court.
