

ALIEN PUNISHED.

**Had Failed to Register Particulars
in England.**

Alexander Senest, age 30, an Austrian, described as an auctioneer, was sent to prison for six months by Mr. Cancellor at Thames Court.

The charge was that he had failed to furnish particulars of his place of business and the date of his arrival in England. The police said his finger-prints showed he had been convicted of felony in England.
