

Taken From Train; Held as Prisoners

Big Surprise for Austrians Who Expected to Travel Through Canada

Port Huron, Mich., Aug. 25.—Ten Austrian reservists from Chicago and Milwaukee, who were en route from New York, have been taken from trains on the Grand Trunk Railway at Sarnia and are being held as prisoners of war, it was learned here to-day. On purchasing their tickets they failed to realize they placed themselves in the hands of the enemy on entering Canada. It is probable they will be taken to Toronto and held until the close of the war.
