

# GEN. OTTER IS TO MAKE TRIP THROUGH CANADA

## Officer Having in Charge Order Respecting "Alien Enemies" to Tour Dominion

MONTREAL, Nov. 1.—Major General Sir William D. Otter, C.B., C.V.O., former inspector general of Canadian militia, who has been appointed by the Federal government to direct the work of carrying out the order in council respecting "alien enemies" with headquarters in Toronto, was in Montreal today and with Silas H. Carpenter, the registrar of alien enemies in Montreal, visited militia headquarters.

Asked as to his plans, General Otter said he was going to make a trip of inspection throughout the Dominion and was commencing at Montreal. Until he had looked into matters he could give no outline of the plans that would be adopted to carry into full effect the intention of the government to guard the country and empire from possible danger from the presence of Austrians and Germans.
