

Prisoners of War Are Well Treated

German Writes and Shows Appreciation of His Con- dition

The following is an extract from a letter from a German prisoner of war in Stanley Barracks. The letter is now in the possession of Mr. J. Goodman of 61 Queen street west.

"I am glad I can sleep in a bed this night. I like it better here than in Brantford in the Police Station. We have good food here and the soldiers are very kindly to me. Here are about 60 or 65 prisoners. I was glad that you were not in the station at Brantford. Two soldiers brought us with bayonets to Toronto like a criminal between them. Remember to write to me."
