

# GEN. HUGHES IN TORONTO

## Reviews Troops and Voices Necessity for Total Abstinence

Toronto, Nov. 15—Major-General Sam Hughes paid his expected visit to the Exhibition camp yesterday. He was received at the station by Major General Lessard, Colonel S. Denison and Captain Reginald Pellatt.

The minister of militia first inspected the principal quarters at the camp. Subsequently the two battalions were drawn up in quarter column for inspection.

Addressing the men, the minister impressed on them the necessity for total abstinence.

The minister afterward visited Stanley Barracks and saw the aliens interned there. He then drove to the Russell Motor Works and inspected some armored motor trucks under construction, leaving in the afternoon for Welland.

In the afternoon the Home Guard 2,542 strong, was reviewed by General Lessard.
