

Austrian Arrested As an Accomplice

With Four Compatriots Will be Tried on Capital Charge

Still another Austrian, Martin Kremitz was arrested yesterday charged with being an accomplice in the murder of Harry Zakowski, a compatriot, who died on Monday at the General Hospital, from injuries received in fight at a christening party at Harry Futas' boarding house, 309 Weston road, on November 22. This makes the fifth man to be arrested for this charge. All are Austrians. Kremitz was found in a house on Seventh avenue. He managed to escape soon after the fight when the police raided the boarding house, but his identity was revealed at the inquest.
