

# **Interned Aliens Split Into Cliques**

## **But Solitary Turk Has No One to Become Friendly With**

---

Arthur Zurzow, the German officer in connection with whom Emil Nerlich is held on a charge of treason, walked in the "bull pen" at Stanley Barracks yesterday, arm in arm with Paul Jockel.

As the interned prisoners walked in the same direction, round and round the barbed wire enclosure in which they are allowed to take exercise, it was noticed that the prisoners split up with cliques, well-to-do with well-to-do, Germans with Germans, Austrians with Austrians, while in the centre of the enclosure, with arms folded, in solitary defiance, stood a Turk, indignant still that he, who claims to be a British subject, should be arrested at Niagara and imprisoned for attempting to leave Canada without an exit.
