

No Pro-Germans at Technical School

Two Teachers Born in Germany Are Naturalized—Another is U. S. Citizen

Principal McKay outlined the years of the Advisory Industrial Committee of the Board of Education yesterday, when it was intimated by Trustee Ellis that there were three German teachers on the staff of the Technical School. Principal McKay stated that Mr. Gustav Hahn and Mr. Arthur Bloomhart, although born in Germany, had been naturalized, and that Mr. P. A. Spangenberg was a citizen of the United States. All were earnest workers and had never expressed any pro-German sympathies. The matter was allowed to drop.

The estimates of Principal McKay for the Central Technical School and its branches, which amounted to \$115,467, were approved. The nominations for the staff of the new Technical School, as submitted by Principal McKay, were also approved.

The committee decided to pay the claims of the father of the Kincaid boy, who had a finger cut off on the buzz saw at the Technical School. The claim was for \$20.
