

WILL INTERN MAZUR.

Port Hope Youth Found Not Guilty of Second Charge.

Acquitted on a charge of conspiring to commit high treason with three other Port Hope Austrians, Paul Mazur was again placed in the dock in the Assizes to-day on a charge of high treason.

Crown Counsel DuVernet told the jury that as the acts were the same in both cases, he would submit no evidence, although he was convinced that the facts showed a crime against the law.

Chief Justice Mulock instructed the jury to return a verdict of "not guilty." Mazur will be interned.
