

ALIEN ENEMIES EMPLOYED BY ONTARIO FIRMS?

QUESTION RAISED IN THE COMMONS OVER TORONTO AND HAMILTON CONCERNS.

(Canadian Associated Cable.)

London, July 13.—In the House of Commons to-night Mr. Wilson asked the Minister of Munitions if he was aware that the National Car Company of Hamilton and the Canadian Car Company of Toronto, who had contracts to manufacture munitions for the British Government, were employing Austrians and Germans and paying the workmen less than the standard rate. Would he take steps to prevent the employment of alien enemies on the manufacture of munitions?

Mr. Maitland, replying, said: "We have no information in the particular cases referred to. The Minister of Munitions has full confidence that the Canadian Government will take steps to deal with the matter."

Norwegian Steamer Caught Taking Copper to Germany

Stockholm, July 13.—The captain of the Norwegian vessel Hannah has been arrested for attempting to smuggle copper from the United States into Germany, having arranged with the German Government for a return cargo of zinc. A German torpedo boat and a submarine were to have met the vessel at the Island of Winga in order to take the copper on board.
