

ALGOMA STEEL'S DENIAL

Labor Trouble Not Due to Alien Enemy or Wage-Cut

Toronto, July 22.—The Algoma Steel Corporation declared that it is untrue that the strike at their works was due to the employment of Germans and Austrians and to the fact that the company announced a ten per cent decrease in wages. No such announcement was made. The men asked to be paid at the old rates provided the company was operating normally and at full time. All the men who were disaffected have returned to work, the company having made its position frankly clear to them. The company indicated its intention of having the men share in its prosperity when such returned to it again. No contract from the British Government for bullet metal was ever received ~~as~~ has been reported.
