

Four Austrians Tried to Leave

Police Had Been Keeping
Watch for a
Week

A week ago, Sergeant of Detectives Alec Mackie, learned that a number of Austrian resisters working in a downtown factory, intended going over to the United States and from there would try to get back to their own country via Holland. Several officers were assigned to keep track of them and, as was expected, early to-day four of them were seen to go down to the Yonge street dock, book a passage for Queenston and board the 7.30 Niagara boat. They were followed by P. C. Hess and Government Interpreter Goodman and were placed under arrest. The names of the men are John Robert, John Popouyck, Alec Boyto and Mikel Berschek.

They appear before Chief Constable Grasett, Registrar of Aliens, to-day and will in all likelihood be interned. They are all registered as alien enemies. Several other aliens are being watched.
