

ANTI-GERMAN LEAGUE FORMED AT PUBLIC TORONTO MEETING

Germans are Germans and
Should be Used Without
Kid Gloves

Toronto, Feb. 11.—At a public meeting here last night a committee was appointed to organize a branch in Toronto of an anti-German League which has as its motto, "no German goods, no German labor, no German immigrants." Resolutions were passed calling the Government's attention to the necessity of imposing a penalizing duty on all goods imported from Germany and Austria after the war, and to dismiss all Germans in the government service.

"It is time we took off our kid gloves," said Controller Cameron, who presided. "This is not a friendly game, this is war. Some of these Germans occupy some of the best strategic positions in our government. I don't care how loyal they are, how good, for the good of the country they should be asked to step out. It is all right to say they are loyal, but they are Germans. The very fact of some of them being German born is enough to have them thrown out."
