

# GOT PRO-GERMAN PAPER

## Arrested at Request of Dominion Police

---

The first arrest in Toronto for receiving prohibited anti-British newspapers through the mails occurred last night when Michael Lipka, an Austrian, boarding at 294 Adelaide street west, was taken into custody on this charge by plainclothesman Hess. The arrest was made at the instigation of the Dominion police, and as the result of the accused receiving regular copies of "Derenuk Ludowz," a Socialistic paper printed in Chicago in the Austrian language, and said to be strongly pro-German.

The act prohibiting pro-German papers here was passed about a year ago, and the penalty is fixed at \$1,000 and costs or six months in jail.
