

RETURNED SOLDIERS RAIDED THE FACTORY

Five Austrians Were Removed
and Marched to Police Station
in Toronto.

TORONTO, April 19.—In spite of the truce, returned soldiers to the number of fifty, last night, executed a raid on the factory of the Sheet Metal Products company, formerly the Kemp Mfg. Company., of which Sir Edward Kemp, Minister of Militia, is head. Neither the police nor the public were aware that it had taken place until the fifty soldiers marched their prisoners, five Austrians, to Agnes street station.

The Austrians held the permission of the registrar of alien enemies to be at large and were released.

The men scaled a gate fifteen feet in height to obtain access to the factory. They did no damage.
