

TO HELP THE ALIEN OUT.

Minister of Labor to Arrange Transportation to Ports of Sailing.

Toronto, Feb. 20.—If aliens now in Canada will be admitted to their home countries, and if shipping facilities can be placed at their disposal at Halifax or St. John, it is the intention of the minister of labor, Hon. Gideon Robertson, to arrange land transportation for a few thousand aliens in southern Ontario, who are waiting and are anxious to obtain transportation home.

This is the substance of a letter from Hon. Mr. Robertson, read at a meeting of the Toronto Trades and Labor council tonight.
