

Sixteen "prisoners of war" held in Vancouver at the city jail since shortly after the start of operations in the war theatres of Europe, were transferred to Nanaimo yesterday by the military authorities, who have established an internment base there for the province. Several prisoners from Victoria have also been sent to Nanaimo. - The majority of the men under restraint are army reservists who endeavored to leave the country with the object of rejoining the colors of the nations with which Great Britain is at war.
