

# 603 RESERVISTS SAFE IN JAIL

OTTAWA — Six hundred and three subjects of the kaiser and the Emperor Francis Joseph are safe in Canadian prisons. And there they will stay to the end of the war. About 400 are Austrians-Galicians, and the rest, Germans. All are reservists who, at the outbreak of hostilities, made an attempt to return home to join the colors.

Those held in jail are not all who have been arrested. Possibly 1,200 have been caught trying to return, but half of this number swore allegiance to the British flag and were given their freedom. The places of detention are Halifax, St. John, Montreal, Kingston, Toronto, Saut Ste. Marie, Winnipeg, Regina, Lethbridge, Nanaimo and Victoria.
