

Greek Recruits' Joke on a Turk

Whether the three Turks arrested at Coleman the other day get to the military prison here or not, the Germans and Austrians already incarcerated therein will have Turk for Christmas. One of the citizens of the Ottoman empire, Ali Antonio Salman, captured Wednesday as a prisoner of war will have the distinction of being the first Turk to enter the

doors of the prison as a prize of war.

Salman came in from the states as a Greek, accompanied by two real Greeks, who came to the city to enlist in the second Canadian contingent. The Greeks knew the Turkish tongue, and after a series of questions learned that Salman was a Turk and not a Greek. They then held a council of war, and determined to turn the Sultan's subject over to

the authorities. This they did and the Turk was taken in charge by Sergt. Coleridge upon his arrival in Lethbridge. He was to have been sent out to the concentration camp at the Fair Grounds today, to watch the progress of the war behind the bars.
