

ARE PROVED TO BE AUSTRIANS

The six men who were caught at Milk River on May 30th, while trying to escape to the United States in cars driven by Lethbridge chauffeurs, have been found to be all Austrians. Two of the number, Baltich and Krichovitch previously admitted that they were of Austrian birth, but claimed that the other four were Montenegrins. Supt. Pennelather was suspicious from the first, however, and by cross-questioning them closely, forced them to admit that they were from Bosnia, which being an Austrian possession, makes them Austrians. The six were sent out this afternoon to the internment camp—two of them may be charged with perjury for testifying that the other four were Montenegrins.
