

AGITATORS WILL BE SENT TO BRANDON CAMP

Agitators, either of enemy nationality or otherwise, who seek to stir up strife among the foreign element in the city and to cause needless trouble for the authorities who are anxious to do all that lies in their power to provide work for the unemployed, received a sharp reminder yesterday of the dangers which they incur, when one of the agitators responsible for Monday's unemployed demonstration in the market

square, was interned and will be sent to Brandon as an undesirable.

By a coincidence, this very man was under close observation by the intelligence department previous to the said meeting. A short time ago a loyal citizen of Winnipeg informed the authorities that a certain Austrian, wearing the uniform of a large corporation, was going from one employment office to another when he was off duty. At these places he naturally found groups of his compatriots outside, and he was observed to address them in their own language. The Englishman shadowed the man from one office to another, and was convinced by the man's excited manner that he was seeking to make trouble. This information he communicated to the registrar of alien enemies.

The man interned is an Austrian, 32 years of age, with his wife but no children in Canada. He speaks fair English, and is known under an alias, this in itself being highly significant. It should further be pointed out that any one with the privileges and rights of a British subject who seeks

to cause dissatisfaction among the aliens of enemy nationality, is rendering himself to a much more serious charge than the Austrian interned this morning, and may find himself in a place with far less attractions than the internment camp at Brandon. The charge in this case would be treason.

Up to noon yesterday 12,887 aliens of enemy nationality have been registered at Colony street, and the number of applications for passports or travelling permits continues to be very heavy.

Ten aliens regarded as undesirables were sent under a strong escort to Brandon yesterday.
