

SHOULD HELP WITH ALIEN REGISTRATION

Brandon, May 5.—That the attitude of the Brandon city council, to the mind of the deputy-minister of justice at Ottawa, in not undertaking local supervision regarding alien registration, is unreasonable, was the purport of a letter read at the regular meeting of the city council last night. The letter added the hope that the police authorities at Brandon would take sufficient interest in the matter to receive the reports and to endeavor to keep in touch with the alien enemy population of the community, this being a service which necessarily can only be performed locally. The communication was ordered to be filed.

It was decided that in future all city laborers be paid by cheque.
