

Must Stay in Camp.—There is no foundation for the rumor which is being industriously circulated in the north end of the city that the prisoners of war now interned at Brandon are to be released immediately. On the other hand the situation is such that increased accommodation has been made at the internment camp. The dispatch which appeared in yesterday's papers, stating that a question had been asked in the British House of Commons as to the number of Germans and Austrians employed in munitions factories at Hamilton and Toronto, Ont., a leading citizen declared yesterday that he could find alien enemies employed in Winnipeg munitions works, and this matter will be investigated by the authorities.
