

Many Home Guards Enlist.

Brøndon, Man., Aug. 18.—The home guards, who have charge of the alien prisoners at the internment camp here, provide a happy hunting ground for the recruiting officers. Men who join that branch of service are apparently not long before desiring to serve with the troops at the front. Twenty-eight men from the 99th battalion have now transferred to the 79th overseas battalion to change guarding prisoners for active service, and there are 17 more waiting to go as soon as their places can be filled by new recruits.
