

AUSTRIAN SENTENCED FOR ATTACK ON YOUNG GIRL

Viriden, Man., May 26.—A young Galician girl was attacked on Nelson street recently by a man who ran away when she screamed. It seems that he wanted to be friendly, and when she resented his advances and called for help, he slapped her face. He was rounded up and proved to be an Austrian named John Kokis. He appeared before Magistrate Jos. Gibson and was sentenced to one month's imprisonment. The magistrate will recommend that he be interned until the end of the war and then return to his own country as an undesirable.
