

WARNING TO ALIENS HERE FOR THE HARVEST

Foreigners who were charged with an infraction of the Alien Registration Act took up the major portion of Magistrate Frasers' time at the police court this morning. They were William Baydux, Nick Mediciniski, Jose Predro and Lpka Varatski. In all cases the defendants advanced the plea that they had not had time to register, or that they did not know that it was necessary to do so immediately after their arrival in town.

The magistrate warned the men that they were liable to a penalty of \$500 and six months in jail for failing to observe the provisions of the act. The fine imposed was \$5 and costs in each case.

Richard Owen Simpson, having pleaded guilty to breaking and entering a store in search, as he said, of eatables, was allowed to go on suspended sentence.

J. W. Watson, charged with being fund drunk, was fined \$10 and costs.
