

PRISONERS OF WAR

Twenty-seven Germans Held at Fort Osborne Barracks.

Winnipeg, Oct. 2.—A guard of six R. N. W. M. Police last night brought in eleven more German prisoners from Regina and delivered them over to the military authorities. The prisoners were at once placed under heavy guard at Fort Osborne barracks. This is the third batch delivered here, and the total number of men now under guard is 27. With this gradual increase and the promise of even more coming, arrangements will shortly be made to transfer them all to larger quarters.
