

MILITARY PRISONERS BROUGHT TO WINNIPEG

Winnipeg, Nov. 2.—Between ten and twelve military prisoners, it is understood, have been brought to Winnipeg since Saturday night and interned at the Fort Osborne barracks. These prisoners, it is said, were all arrested in military district No. 10 by members of the R.N.W.M.P. force, who brought them to Winnipeg. On Sunday night numerous members of the force were to be seen on the down town streets.

It is rumored that this is only the first batch of a group of prisoners numbering almost 30 who have been arrested in the district.
