

More Prisoners at Fort Osborne. — Young Germans and Austrians in western Canada, continue to make attempts to leave for the purpose of joining the armies of their respective countries. Eleven more have been caught at Regina, by the Northwest Mounted Police, and they were brought to Winnipeg and handed over to the military authorities at Fort Garry barracks last night. There are now 63 prisoners of war at the barracks, where they are well cared for but closely guarded.
