

500 AUSTRIANS START ON TREK; SOON DWINDLE

Yesterday afternoon five hundred Austrians, led by a man named Joe Skekableh, started another trek to Emerson, by way of St. Boniface and the C.P.R. tracks. Most of the men were fairly well equipped for the journey, carrying, not only bundles of blankets, but provisions of a kind. It is believed that most of them did not know what fate had befallen their predecessors who trekked last week, but it is also held that some, the ringleaders, have adopted this method to enforce their internment by the military authorities. The foreigners were not hindered by the police or the military and when last seen, about ten miles west of St. Boniface, their numbers had dwindled to about two hundred strong.
