

REGISTERED ALIEN DROWNED

Lost Life Near Plum Coulee—In Beyond Depth in Water Hole.

Plum Coulee, Man., July 22.—Mike Yarn'kof, a registered alien, holding permit 2834, was drowned last evening at 9 o'clock at the farm of J. J. Hooge, eight miles north of the Coulee, where he has been working for the past two weeks.

Yarnikof, along with a fellow Galician laborer, and two of Hoogo's boys, were in bathing in a water hole near the house, Yarnikof got beyond his depth and went down and in spite of all efforts to rescue him, it was 30 minutes before they were able to get him out.

Yarnikof lived at 735 Alfred avenue, and has a brother, John, at 1035 Alfred avenue. He was 19 years old and single; his parents live in the old country. Dr. McGavin, coroner, conducted an investigation and is arranging interment in the Plum Coulee cemetery tomorrow.
