

WINNIPEG SALESMAN IS INTERNED ACROSS BORDER

F. W. Legler, formerly salesman for Bloom Bros., Keewayden building, has been interned at Minneapolis as "an alien enemy dangerous to be at liberty," according to a dispatch received today. He was registered as an alien enemy here, the military authorities assert, but left for the south 18 months ago.

Legler boasted in Minneapolis that it was an easy matter to send information to Germany by way of Canada and Sweden, it is asserted. T. T. Bower, assistant postmaster here, says this is nonsense. Legler is also alleged to have tried to send pictures of American military encampments to Germany and when arrested, the dispatch says, he had a camera and a number of pictures on him. He is known to have visited "several military camps recently, the dispatch continues, and obtained a pass to visit Camp Dodge, near Des Moines, Iowa.
