

Awaits Verdict on Sedition Charge

Charged with seditious utterances, Louise Bedkir, wife of a German-Canadian, Moosehorn, Man., awaits the verdict of the assize court jury which retired at noon today after hearing the case.

Mrs. Bedkirk is charged with having said to a Dominion police officer entering her home in search of an alleged Military act defaulter:

"You laugh now. I will laugh later."

According to the police she attempted to shield her brother-in-law from the Dominion authorities. Charges of threatening to shoot, and obstructing a police officer were dismissed by Mr. Justice Curran at Monday's hearing.
