

FIRST PARTY OF DEPORTED HUNS DUE HERE TONIGHT

More than 100 Germans who have been interned at Vernon, B.C., are expected to pass through Winnipeg tonight on a special train bound for the east. They are to be deported, military officials declare, and are the first batch from an internment camp to pass through Winnipeg. They are under guard.

So far no word has been received here regarding the deportation of alien enemies interned at Kompasskasing, the camp to which Germans and Austrians taken in this military district were sent, but they, too, will be sent back home, it is stated.
