Citizens of Beausejour Have Little
Use for Canadian-Ukrainian.

WINNIPEG, March 27.—A Mr. Vasizty, who declared himself a representative of the Ukrainian-Canadian Citizens' League, had a rough time of it in Beausejour, Man., Monday night when he called a meeting of citizens. He declared he was seeking money to send a Canadian-Ukrainian delegate to the peace conference. Citizens then took charge of the meeting. He was escorted to the station by a deputation which stopped every 15 feet to make him kiss the Union Jack and repeat that he was a loyal Canadian citizen. He was put on the Winnipeg train and told not to return.
