

TEACHERS ASK FOR EXPULSION OF HUTTERITES

Unanimous Resolution Passed at Final Meeting Manitoba Edu- cational Association

WINNIPEG, April 24.—A motion asking that immediate steps be taken to deport the Hutterites as undesirable citizens was passed without a dissenting vote at the final session of the Manitoba Educational association this afternoon. Other motions passed included the barring of all immigration into Canada for at least ten years to come of persons from alien enemy countries, and that all conscientious objectors be classified as "undesirable citizens."

Total prohibition, making the manufacture, sale and importation of all spirituous liquors, except for medicinal purposes, illegal was approved.

The convention endorsed a pension scheme for teachers and a recommendation asking the government to appoint a commission to inquire into the whole question of teachers' salaries and conditions of work. The survey will take in all western provinces.
