

VETS DECIDE TO "CLEAN-OUT" DANGEROUS ALIENS

NORRIS WIRES OTTAWA: 'GREAT DISCONTENT'

TELLS WHITE VETS INSIST ON ACTION

Premier Sends Message After
Provincial Cabinet
Meeting

REPORTS ON CONFERENCE

A telegram, directing the attention of the Ottawa government to the fact that returned soldiers in Manitoba demand immediate deportation of dangerous alien enemies, was dispatched this afternoon to Sir Thomas White, acting premier, by Premier Norris.

The message, which was sent after a meeting of the provincial cabinet, reads as follows:

"Deputation of returned men, about 150, waited on this government urging immediate internment and deportation of alien enemies. Also want all property belonging to aliens confiscated and money applied to the orphans' and widows' fund. Strong speeches were made. Great discontent among returned men owing to the presence of so many alien enemies. Very insistent that something be done."

Returned soldiers, who saw a copy of the telegram, pointed out that it constituted only a report of what transpired at the conference Thursday evening.
