

BUCKA JUDGMENT RESERVED

WINNIPEG, Oct. 29.—Judgment was reserved by Judge Pallerson in the case of Bishop Bucka, when the trial was brought to a close today. The charges pressed against the bishop were failure to register as an enemy alien and to report once a month. Two witnesses were called today to prove the good character of the Austrian prelate. Ge. Szkwarcz, M.A., director of the Ruthenian educational institute, St. Boniface, testified to the loyalty and patriotism of the defendant and H. Kraemer stated that the bishop had done considerable recruiting for the Ruthenian forestry detachment.
