

ALIEN ENEMIES IN CANADA TO SAW WOOD

In Western Canada Men in Detention Camps Will Work in Dominion Parks

OTTAWA, Nov. 24.—Alien enemies of Great Britain will have to saw wood in Canada this winter to pay their board. The Ottawa government some time ago asked both the Ontario and the Quebec governments to designate timbered areas upon the clearing of which aliens held as prisoners of war could be employed. It is understood that the Quebec government has reserved a considerable area in the Abitibi region to be cleared up, and turned into good farms. Ontario has not yet replied.

In Western Canada, the federal government will set prisoners of war at work improving Dominion parks. Germans and Austrians thereby will be enabled to work out their anti-British spleen upon good, tough Canadian stumps. It is figured that they will earn their board, improve their health, promote public safety and improve the land.
