

More War Prisoners Leave.

The second squad of foreigners to be taken from Fort Henry were sent on the C.N.R. train on Monday afternoon to Hearst. As the three kinds, Germans, Austrians and Turks, do not mix well together, all of those sent to Hearst were Germans. The Germans are blamed by the Austrians for starting the war, and the result of their arguments would be general if they were not carefully watched. For that reason Fort Henry will be more of a temporary concentration camp from now on, and the three nationalities will be gradually separated and sent to different places.
