

CAMP FOR INTERNED ALIENS NEAR HEARST HAS 1,000 PRISONERS

There are now about 1,000 prisoners, interned aliens, at the concentration camp at Kapuskasing, on the National Transcontinental, Kapuskasing River, where the soil is excellent for agricultural purposes, as the location is right in the heart of the Clay Belt.

A town is laid out in regular military style, and a large section of land has been cleared, plowed and put in crop. It is expected that there will be 2,000 prisoners there by fall.
