Toronto, Dec. 29.—Paul Jockel, a young German clerk, who escaped from an internment camp and then obtained a position in a munition factory in Hamilton, was ordered to be interned by Chief of Police Grasett to-day, till the end of the war. He will go either to Kapuskasing camp or Fort Henry. He had been sent down in Hamilton for 18 months for forgery.
