

Interned Aliens Worked

Ottawa, May 3.—A statement given to Parliament today by the Minister of Justice shows that since the war began 2,961 interned aliens of enemy nationality have been employed on various public works. They have cleared land, have built roads and ditches in the new experimental farm in the vicinity of the internment camps, principally in Northern Ontario and Quebec. None have been employed on industrial work. The interned aliens include 212 Germans, 2611 Austrians and 139 Turks.
