

IN NORTH ONTARIO TO CLEAR UP 500 QUARTER SECTIONS

Ontario Gov't Getting Two Whole Townships Ready for Settlers' Farms

Toronto, Nov. 1.—As a starter upon a far reaching policy of settling northern Ontario by making partly cleared farms available for incoming settlers, the Ontario Government is taking steps to have two whole townships on the Transcontinental partly cleared this winter. By next spring it is hoped that at least five hundred quarter sections will be cleared and ready for settlement in the townships of Idington and Owens. The Government proposes to make the pulpwood upon the townships pay for the clearing. Tenders for the sale of all the pulpwood and timber will be called for at once. The firm whose tender is accepted will be asked to complete the work by June next.
