

ALL FOREIGNERS MUST REGISTER ON JUNE 22

The registration of June 22nd, which is purely civilian, and which takes in all citizens between the ages of 16 and 60, will include citizens of the United States, and all foreigners, no matter what their nationality. After June 22nd, the only registration card which will be accepted in Canada as entitling the holder to privileges of travel, etc., will be the Canadian card, which means that an American with an American registration card must also take out a Canadian card if he wishes to enjoy the privileges of this country. Arrangements have been made whereby Canadians who leave for the United States or Newfoundland before June 22 may register immediately upon their return.
