

# 1,200 ALIENS ARE EAGER FOR PEACE

## Believe Defeat of Fatherland Means Release From Internment

---

More than 1,200 alien enemies interned at Kupas Kasing eagerly await news that the war has ended, it was learned today. Some of them have been there since the first few weeks of the war and of these many are having better food now than ever in their lives, it is said.

The end of the war will not mean their immediate release, alien enemy custodians here say. The publication of the peace announcement will not be taken as a signal for release, but authorization will be awaited from Ottawa. That will not come, it is believed, until after peace has been signed.

Several alien enemies registered today at the local office. Others obtained permits to travel and many made their regular reports. This will continue in the same routine until peace has been declared, local officials assert.
